Baltimore County Democratic Party Elects New Chair

TOWSON, MD — The Baltimore County Democratic State Central Committee (BCDSCC) has elected 2nd Vice-Chair Dr. Charlotte Wood, PhD, MBA, MSN, RN, a college professor, as the new Chair during their April meeting. Representing District 44A, Dr. Wood brings a wealth of leadership experience from her role as a Professor at the School of Nursing at Coppin State University and her previous position as President of the Maryland Nurses Association.
